(*Miriam.*)  
Who can protect others? (*I can.*)

**WEEK 3:**  
Josiah the young king  
does what's right.

**2 CHRONICLES 34**  
What kid became King and did what was right?  
(*Josiah.*)  
Who can do what's right? (*I can.*)

**WEEK 4:**  
A boy helps others by  
sharing his lunch.

**JOHN 6:1-13**  
What kid shared his lunch with everyone?  
(*The boy.*)  
Who can help others? (*I can.*)

**WEEK 5:**  
You can do what God wants  
you to do because you rock!

**1 TIMOTHY 4:12**  
Name 3 kids in the Bible that rock.  
(*Jesus, Samuel, David, Daniel, Miriam,  
Josiah, or the boy with his lunch.*)  
Who rocks? (*Kids rock!*)





Use washable crayons or markers.
